Framing our Conversation

Key point of Uncharitable: Take the constraints off of nonprofits; allow them the freedoms we give to businesses.

Why? Because the issues the nonprofit sector is trying to solve are urgent, life-saving, and critical.

What constraints? Barriers (perceived and real) that keep nonprofits from investing generously in their people, marketing, and research

Where do the constraints come from? Sense that "sacrifice = good".
