






92 million Americans live in or near poverty\*

Including nearly


1 in 3

# Structural barriers prevent eligible people from accessing support Recent federal changes will make it worse

#### **Barriers**:

- Program rules are <u>confusing</u>
- Researching and applying is <u>time intensive</u>
- Programs and applications are <u>fragmented</u>

Even seasoned navigators find it challenging to learn about all the programs and keep up with changes






**One-Stop Universal Benefits Screener** 

## Responsive to families, who wanted a tool that was anonymous, fast and flexible

- No account or personally identifiable information required
- Optional ability to exclude programs that a household is already receiving
- Fully translated into 12 languages
- Readability at middle school level

## **PILOT PROGRAM**

#### What worked?

- Strong ties to the community built on trust and long-time relationships
- Existing membership base
- App offered all available benefits and resources in one place
- Informed families of resources beyond the popular ones
- Supports CBOs to engage their membership base/community
- Given the current political and socio-economic climate, MFB-NC offered a new way to identify assistance without leaving their home
- Easy to navigate and digitally accessible

## **PILOT PROGRAM**

#### **Complexities:**

- Staying consistent to follow-up with families about benefit eligibility
- Ensuring CBOs have culturally competent staff and aware of resources and resources eligibility
- Language accessibility for multilingual communities who qualify but aren't aware of services available
- Wording of applications makes the resources inaccessible due to their complexity

# **Building Community Power through Issue Organizing**

## **PROGRAM OUTCOMES**

- Base building: Build relationships with community members and recruit them into organizations through one-on-ones and addressing issues that directly impact them
- Data: Track ALL conversations and engagement with community members by using open canvassing data tools and syncing voters into your VAN committee
- **Civic participation:** Engage with community members by including them in your ongoing and existing civic engagement program.
- Accountability: Inform community members about the current state of public benefits, how elections play a role, and share spaces where they can hold elected officials accountable for the current changes taking place.
- Long-term community engagement: Ensure at least 40 individuals complete the public benefits assessment tool *MyFriendBen-NC* by following up with their application results and continuing to engage with them in your organization's programs and activities beyond project completion.

## **Base-Building**

Engaging and activating a large base of permanent volunteers to strengthen movement infrastructure. Civic engagement statistics demonstrate that going beyond the first initial contact to continuous engagement is the foundation for effective base-building and community participation.

Partners data informed Blueprint that a minimum of 3 conversations with individuals helped move them from a contact to an engagement.

- Initial conversation
- Second conversation
- Third conversation
- Long term engagement and member sustainability

## **ROLE PLAYING**
